# Privacy Notice and information on the processing of data

## 1. Purpose, scope of the Privacy Notice and applicable law

The Gyémánt-Pirazol Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (hereinafter referred to as: Service Provider, Data Controller), hereby informs you about its practices regarding the processing of personal data related to the use of the gyemantpirazol.hu website (hereinafter referred to as: Website), its organizational and technical measures taken to protect such data, as well as of your rights in relation to data processing and the means of enforcing your rights.

The Data Controller shall act in accordance with the applicable legislation in force in the course of this information and data processing, in particular with regard to:

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council ("General Data Protection Regulation" /"GDPR")
- Act CXII of 2011 on Informational Self-Determination and Freedom of Information ("Info Act")
- Act V of 2013 on the Civil Code ("CC")
- the provisions of Act XLVIII of 2008 on the Basic Requirements and Certain Restrictions of Commercial Advertising Activities ("Commercial Advertising Act")

### 3. 3. General data processing policy

The data processing of the activities of Gyémánt-Pirazol Kft. is based on voluntary consent and legal authorization. In the case of processing based on voluntary consent, the data subjects may withdraw their consent at any stage of the processing.

# 4 Data sets concerned with the data processing:

The User/Data subject shall provide his/her name, e-mail address and telephone number for contact purposes in the Request for Proposal/Contact Form. These data will be processed by the Data Controller on the basis of the data subject's consent until the end of the business relationship, which will be reviewed by the Data Controller every 6 months.

User may withdraw his/her consent to the processing of your data at any time by sending an email User may withdraw his/her consent to the processing of his/her data at any time by sending a notice to the e-mail address gyemantpirazol@gyemantpirazol.hu .

Data processors may use the data for the performance of their specific tasks and shall not transfer data to third parties without the consent of the user.

# 5. Cookie police

The **gyemantpirazol.hu** website uses cookies to operate the site and to track activity on the website.

A cookie is a small data packet that internet services store in your browser.

# The purpose of cookies:

- collect information about visitors and their devices
- remember visitors' individual preferences
- facilitate the use of the website
- provide a quality user experience

The types of cookies used by the website are listed in a separate table on the website.

## 6. Rights of data subjects and enforcement of rights:

Within the period of processing, the data subject may request information about the processing of his/her personal data and may request the rectification, erasure or withdrawal of his/her personal data, - except for mandatory data, - and may exercise his/her right to data portability and right to object as specified in point 4 at one of the contact details of the controller specified in points 2 and 4.

The Data Controller must respond to the data subject's request within 30 days.

## 6.1 Rights to information

Gyémánt-Pirazol Kft. shall take appropriate measures to provide data subjects with all the information on the processing of personal data referred to in Articles 13 and 14 of the GDPR and all the information referred to in Articles 15 to 22 and 34 of the GDPR in a concise, transparent, intelligible and easily accessible form, in plain language.

# 6.2 Right of access of the data subject

The data subject has the right to receive feedback as to whether his/her personal data are being processed and, if processing is ongoing, the right to access the personal data processed and to be informed of the following information:

- the purposes of the processing;
- the categories of personal data processed;
- information about the recipients or categories of recipients to whom we have disclosed or will disclose the personal data;
- the envisaged period of storage of the personal data or, where this is not possible, the criteria for determining that period;
- the right to request the rectification, erasure or restriction of the processing of personal data relating to him / her and, where the processing is based on legitimate interest, to object to the processing of such personal data
- the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority;
- where the data have not been collected from the data subject, any available information about their source:
- - the fact of automated decision (where such a process is used), including profiling, and, at least in these cases, clear information on the logic used and the significance of such processing and its likely consequences for the data subject.

# 6.3 Right to rectification

The data subject has the right to obtain from Gyémánt-Pirazol Kft. the rectification of inaccurate personal data concerning him or her without delay and to request the completion of incomplete data.

## 6.4 Right to erasure - to be forgotten

The data subject has the right to obtain the erasure of personal data relating to him/her without undue delay where one of the following grounds applies:

- the personal data are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were collected or processed by the controller;
- the data subject withdraws his/her consent and there is no other legal basis for the processing;
- the data subject objects to processing based on legitimate interest and there is no overriding legitimate ground (i.e. legitimate interest) for the processing
- the Data Controller has unlawfully processed the personal data and this has been established on the basis of the complaint,
- the personal data must be erased to comply with a legal obligation under applicable Union or Member State law to which the Data Controller is subject.

Where, for any lawful reason, the Data Controller has disclosed the personal data processed in relation to the data subject and it is obliged to erase it for any of the abovementioned reasons set out above, it takes reasonable steps, - including technical measures -, taking into account the available technology and the cost of implementation, to inform other data controllers processing the data that the data subject has requested the deletion of the links to or copies of the personal data in question.

As a general rule, the Data Controller will not disclose the personal data of the data subject.

The erasure shall not apply where processing is necessary for one of the following reasons:

- to exercise the right to freedom of expression and information;
- to comply with an obligation under applicable Union or Member State law that requires the controller to process personal data (e.g. processing in the context of invoicing, as the storage of invoices is required by law) or for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller;
- for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims (e.g. where the Data Controller has a claim against the data subject and has not yet satisfied it, or where a consumer or Data Controller complaint is pending).

## 6.5 Right to restriction of processing

The data subject shall have the right to obtain from the controller restriction of processing where one of the following applies:

- the accuracy of the personal data is contested by the data subject, for a period enabling the controller to verify the accuracy of the personal data, if the check is not necessary, no restriction is applied;
- the processing is unlawful and the data subject opposes the erasure of the personal data and requests the restriction of their use instead;
- the personal data no longer need for the purposes of the processing, but they are required by the data subject for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims; or
- the data subject has objected to processing, but the controller may also have a legitimate interest in the processing, in this case, until it is established whether the legitimate grounds of the controller prevail over the legitimate grounds of the data subject, the processing should be restricted.

Where processing has been restricted under paragraph 1, such personal data shall, with the exception of storage, only be processed with the data subject's consent or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims or for the protection of the rights of another natural or legal person or for reasons of important public interest of the Union or of a Member State. The Data Controller must inform the data subject in advance (at least 3 working days prior to the lifting of the restriction) of the lifting of the restriction of processing.

### 6.6 Right to data portability

Where the processing is necessary for the performance of a contract or is based on the data subject's voluntary consent, the data subject has the right to request to receive the data he/she has provided to the controller in a commonly understood machine-readable form and format and, where technically feasible, to request that the controller transmit the data to another.

# 6.7 Right to object

The data subject has the right to object, on grounds relating to his/her particular situation, at any time to the processing of his/her personal data on the basis of legitimate interest. In that case, the controller shall no longer process the personal data, unless it demonstrates compelling legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject or for the establishment, exercise or defence of legal claims.

# 6.8 Right to withdraw consent

The data subject has the right to withdraw consent at any time, in which case the Data Controller will delete the data from its systems.

### 7. Legal remedies

- 7.1 If the data subject considers that the Data Controller has infringed a legal provision on data processing or has failed to comply with a request, he or she may initiate proceedings with the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information (postal address: 1530 Budapest, PO Box 5, e-mail: ugyfelszolgalat@naih.hu) to have the alleged unlawful processing stopped.
- 7.2 In the course of the processing, the data subject may have recourse to the courts if his/her rights are infringed.

## 8. Data security

In the operation of IT systems, the necessary rights management, internal organisation and technical solutions are in place to ensure that the data subject's data cannot be accessed by unauthorised persons, and that unauthorised persons cannot delete, extract or modify the data. The Data Controller shall also enforce data protection and data security requirements in relation to its processors. It shall keep a record of any data protection incidents and, where necessary, inform the data subject of any incidents that occur.

## 9. Other provisions

The data Controller reserves the right to modify this Privacy Notice in a way that does not affect the purpose and legal basis of the processing.

The Data Controller informs its customers that the court, the prosecutor, the investigating authority, the infringement authority, the administrative authority, the National Authority for Data Protection and Freedom of Information, the National Bank of Hungary, or other bodies authorised by law may contact the Data Controller to provide information, to communicate or transfer data, or to make documents available.

Gyémánt-Pirazol Kft. will disclose personal data to the authorities only to the extent and to the extent strictly necessary for the purpose of the request, provided that the authorities have indicated the exact purpose and scope of the data.
